Dear Family,

This weekend, the Third Sunday in Ordinary time, we hear Jesus starting to call His Disciples. Jesus looked at Simon and Andrew and said, “Come after me.” Jesus offers that same invitation to each of us. From the time of our Baptism until our earthly demise we are always called to use our talents for the mission work that God has given to us.

Answering Jesus’s call requires us to transform our personal vision and accept His mission. We can make this choice at any time in our lives. We are to turn from that which separates us from God and unite ourselves wholly to him. Simon and Andrew responded by immediately dropping their nets and following Him. Sometimes our own response is the same, but in my experience, most respond at different points in time.

Many of us are given more than one call to discipleship in our lives. So that accounts for the different response times. Also, there are those who have decided to ask for time to decide as to whether this is the best offer, to put our affairs in order, to ensure we have our plans and contingencies in place.

As we go forth today, reflect upon where it is that you stand in your own response to the calling you have been given; pray about it, and make that firm YES to God’s calling and ask for His guidance and strength to fulfill that call.
