## Lent

Ash Wednesday begins the Lenten season on Wednesday, February 14. Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation; but is a very important day of Christian observance. Masses will be at 7:00 AM and 6:00 PM. We will have confessions one half hour before Mass begins and ashes will be distributed during each Mass.

### Lenten Obligations

As stated by the USCCB, "Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards."

Altar server training is Saturday, February 17 after the 8:00 AM Mass until about 10:30. Current servers are expected to attend. Any young man who would like to start serving has received First Communion is encouraged to attend. Direct any questions to Father Rueb or John Almeida.
