The gospel for the Procession of the Palms reads that the crowd following Jesus was joyous at His arrival into Jerusalem. Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread branches they had cut in the fields. Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, "Hosanna! Do you treat them in a Christian way, or do you ridicule them the way that Jesus was ridiculed?

As we enter this Holy week, think, and pray about this issue. God wants to be present in all our lives. Please let Him in.
